

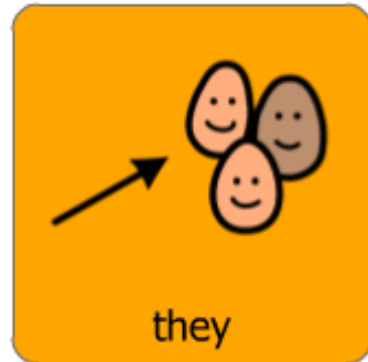
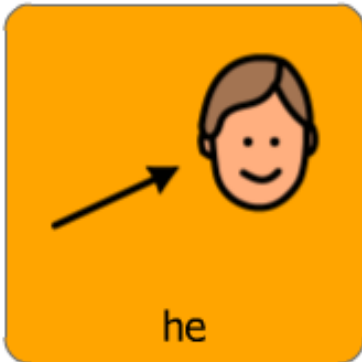
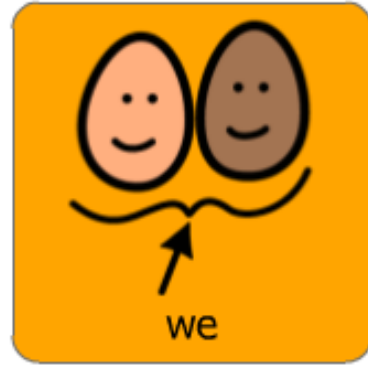
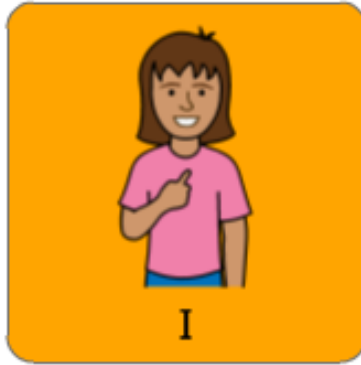
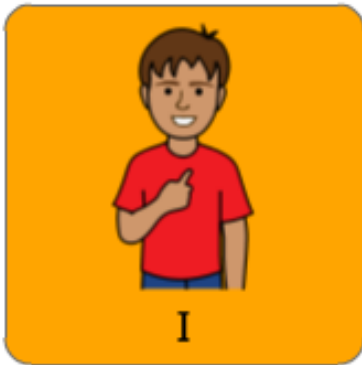
Colourful Semantics - The Rainforest

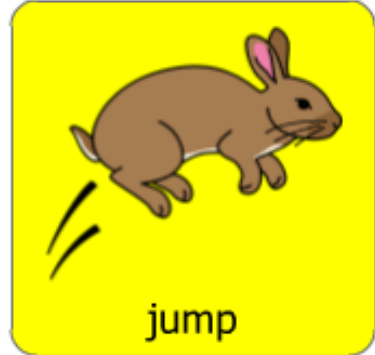
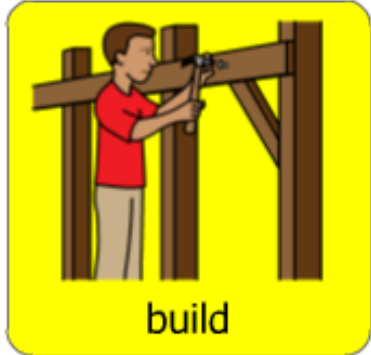
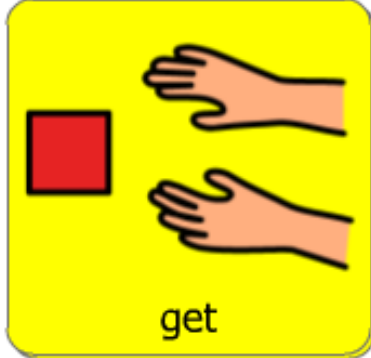
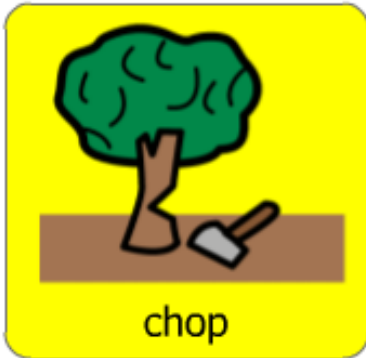
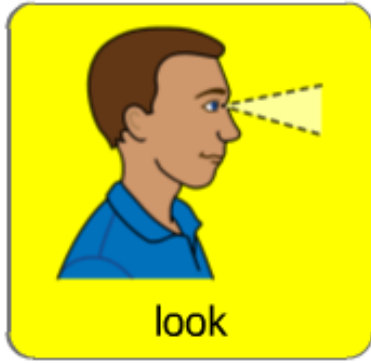
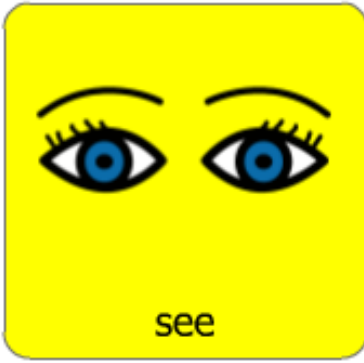
