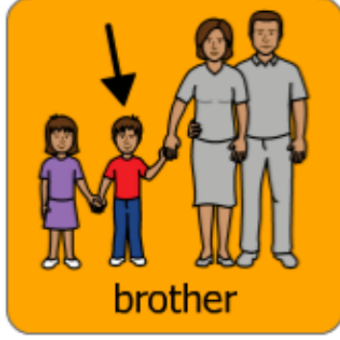
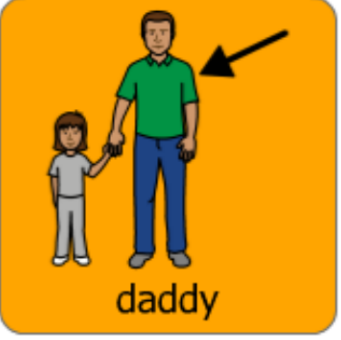
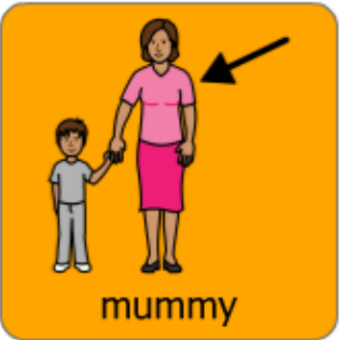
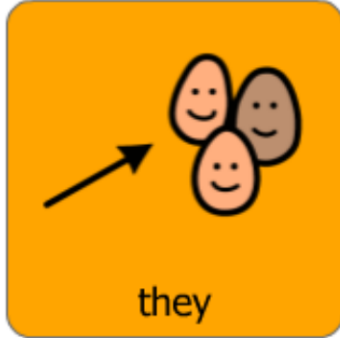
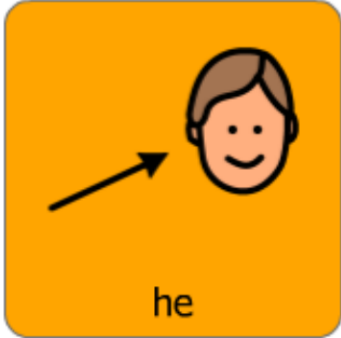
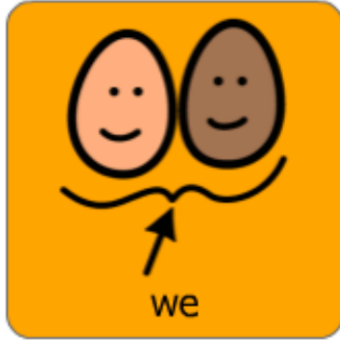
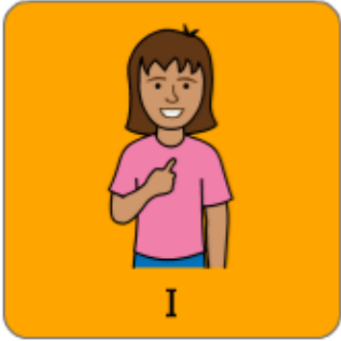
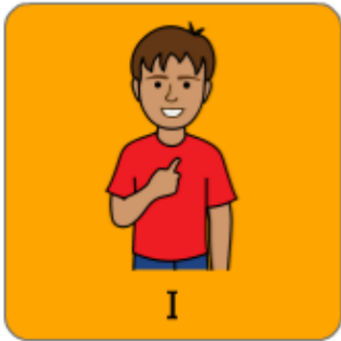


Colourful Semantics - autumn theme

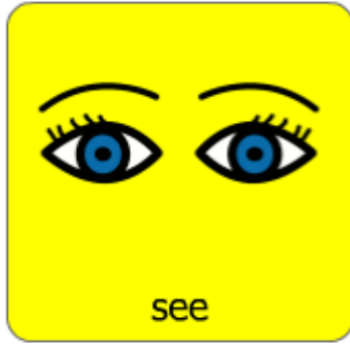


You can prompt them by asking questions such as: ` what animals could you see?`

'did you see any animals?'

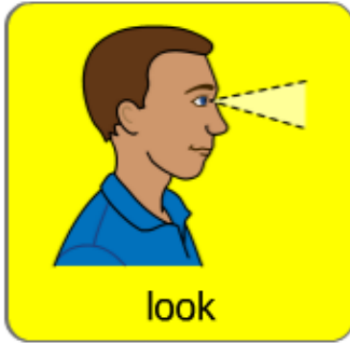
