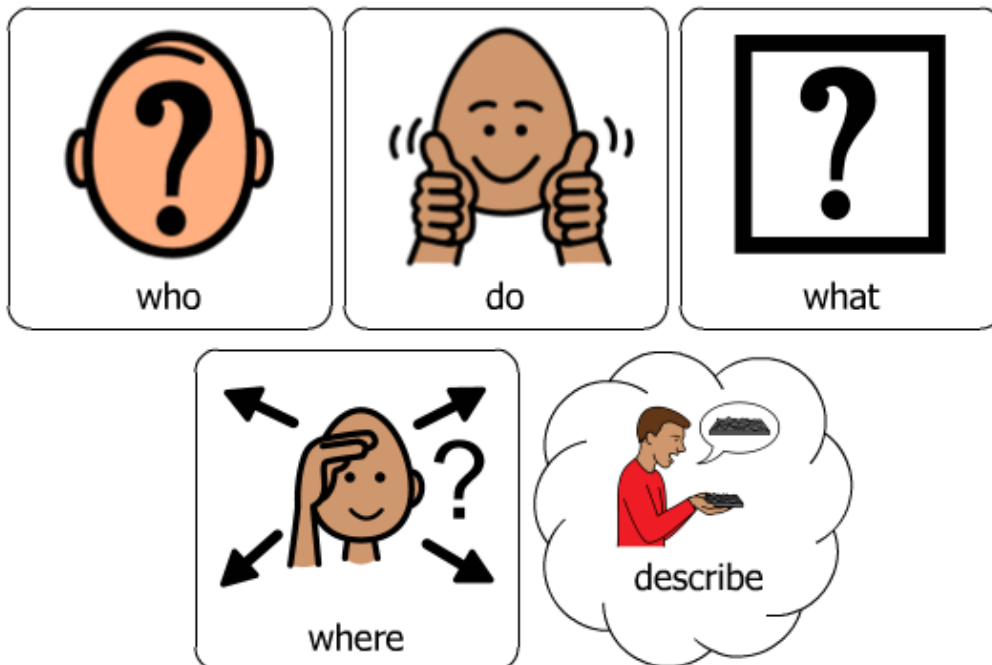


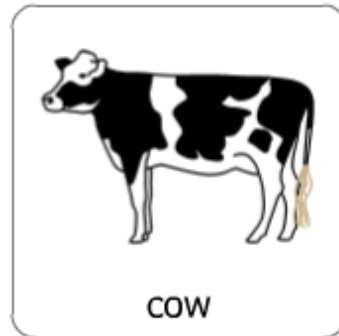
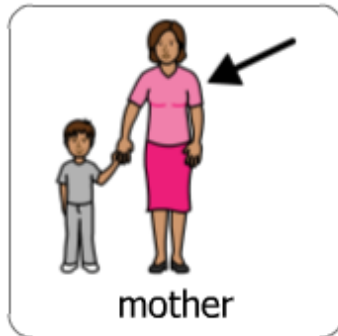
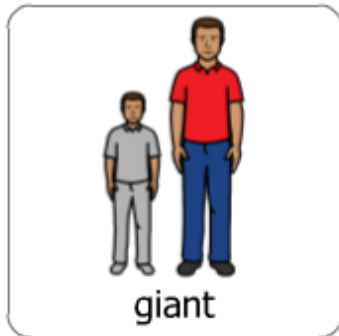
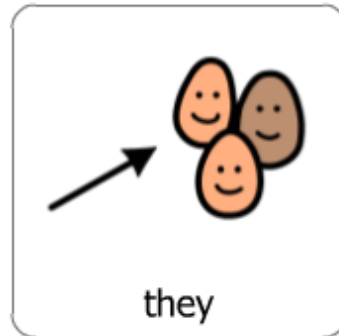
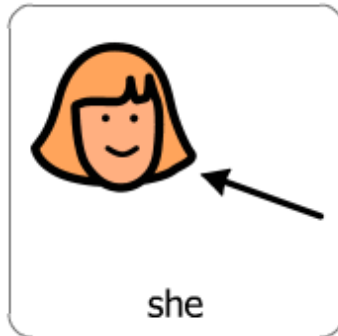
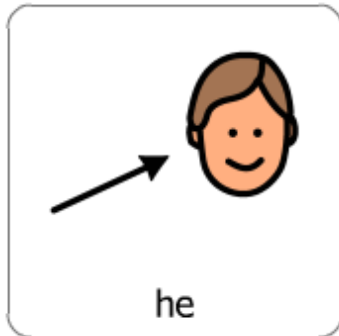
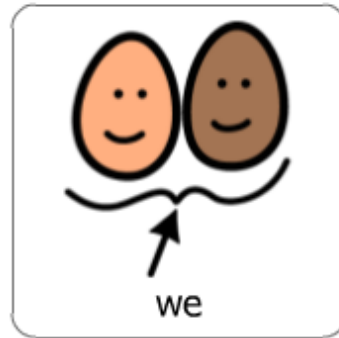
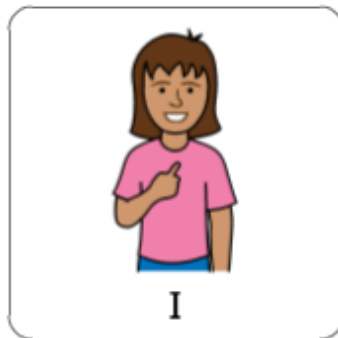
## Colourful Semantics - Jack and the Beanstalk

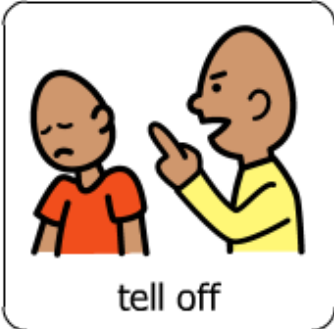
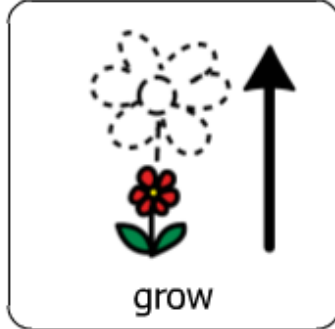
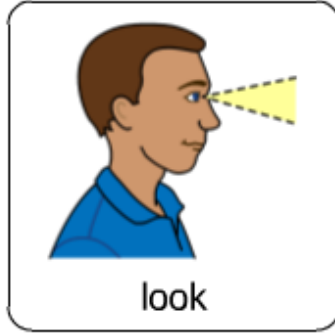
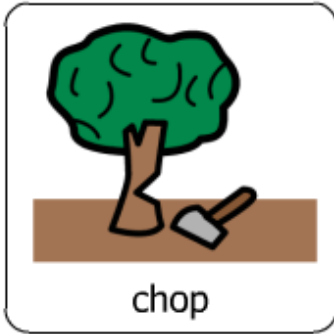
