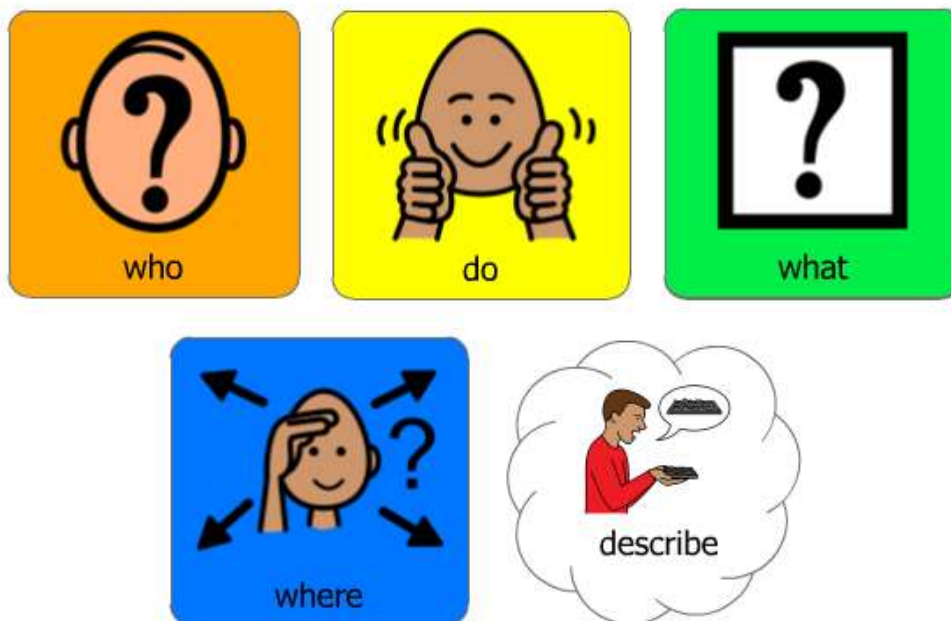


## Colourful Semantics - Diwali

'who did you see during Diwali?'

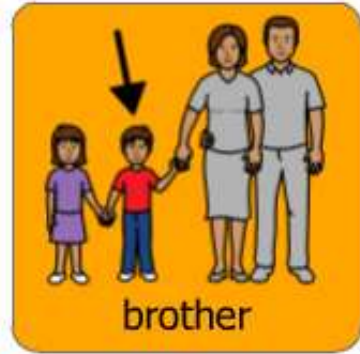
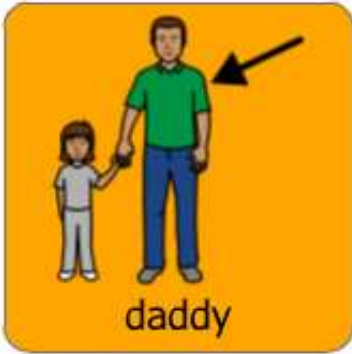
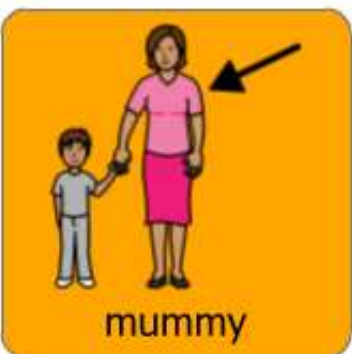
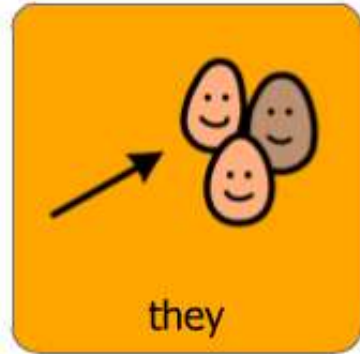
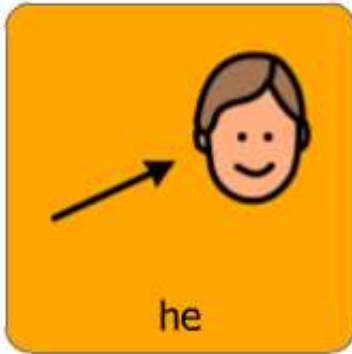
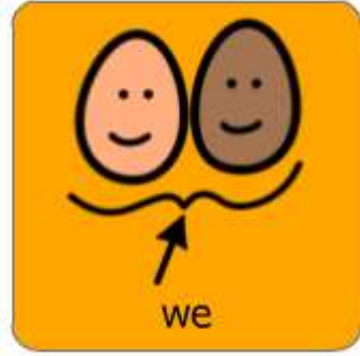
