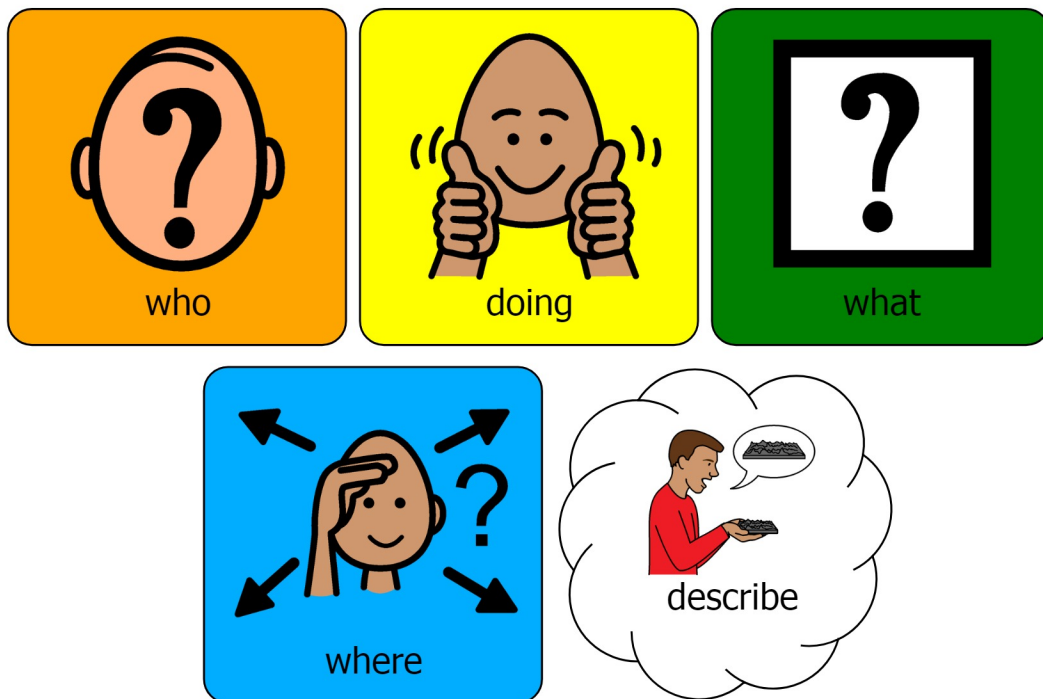


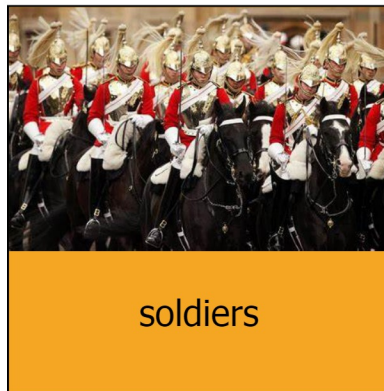
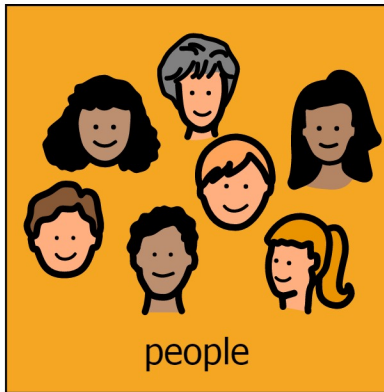
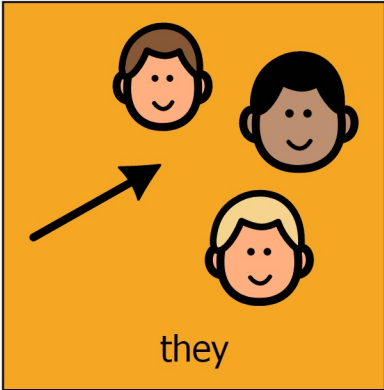
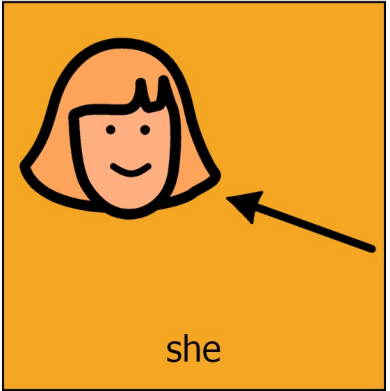
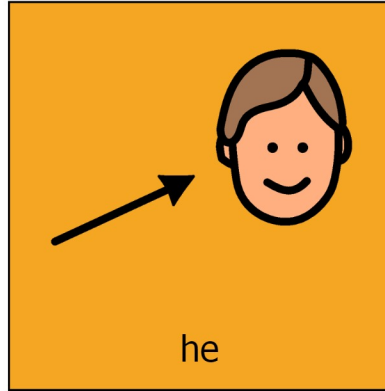
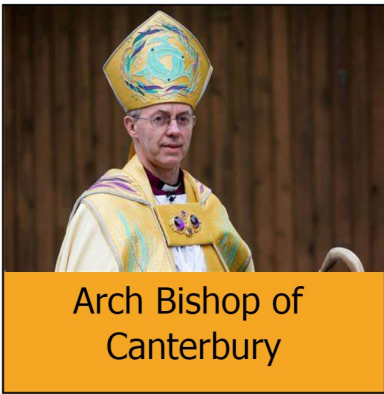
# Colourful Semantics - The Coronation of King Charles III

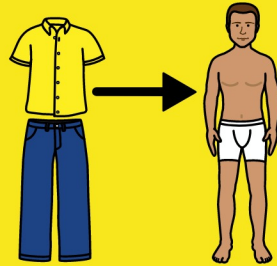
You can prompt them by asking questions such as:

- What does it look like?

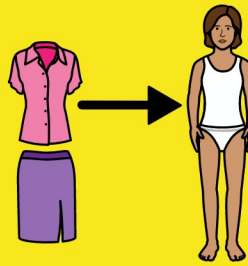
