Assessment and therapy intervention:

ITS speech and language therapists may wish to use such recordings to discuss at clinical supervision and to train other ITS staff on relevant approaches.

External training run by ITS therapists:

Video recordings and digital photography is an essential way to train other professionals such as education staff and health care staff about the communication needs of clients. It is essential to raise awareness in education settings and health care settings, to ensure communication needs are recognised and accommodated for.
