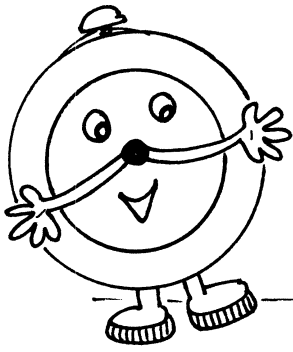

Hello! I'm Tick Tock, the alarm clock,.. and I'm here to tell you about different parts of the day.

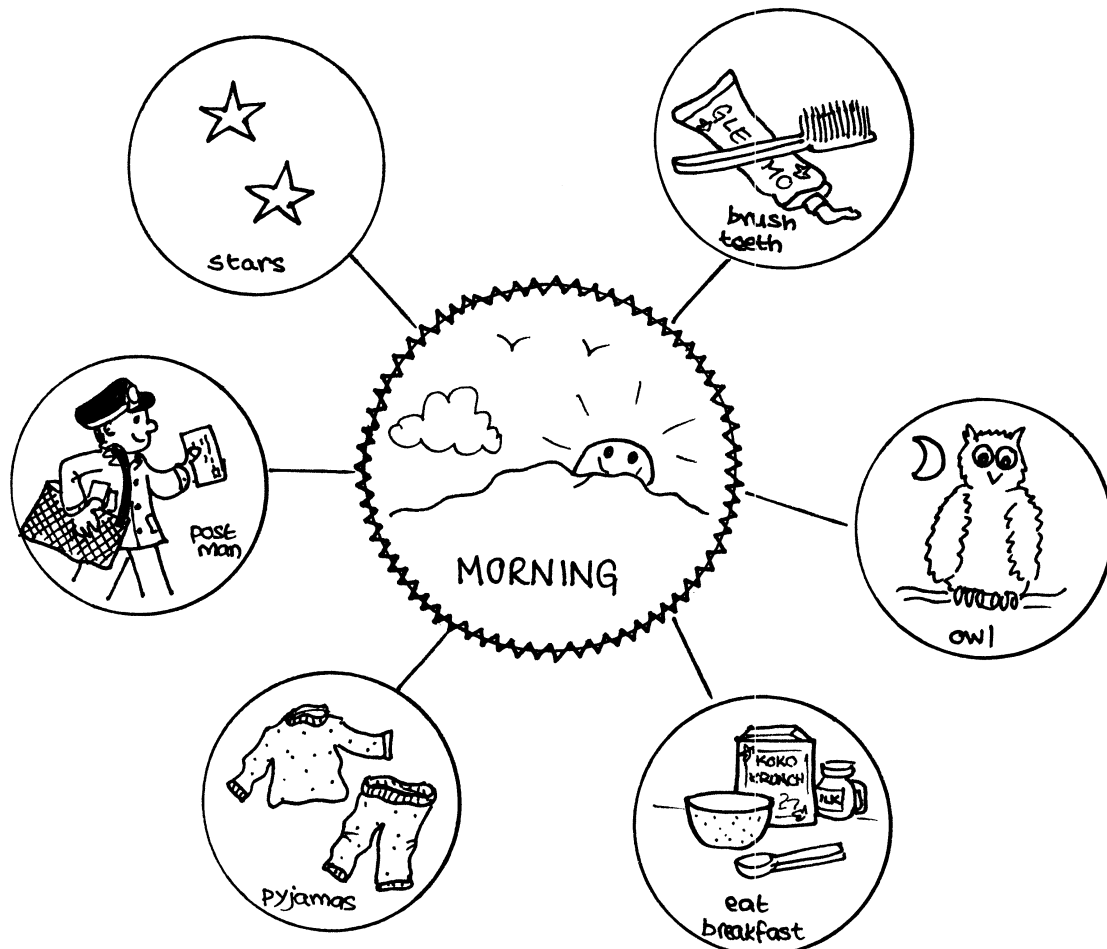
There are LOTS of hours in a day!

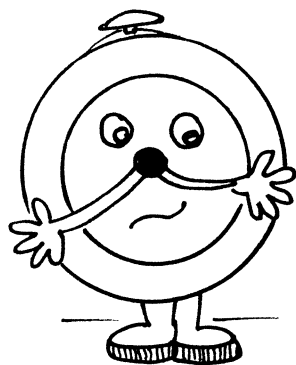
Do you know how many?... 24 hours.

So sometimes we use words to talk about 'chunks' of the day.

The first 'chunk' of the day is the MORNING.

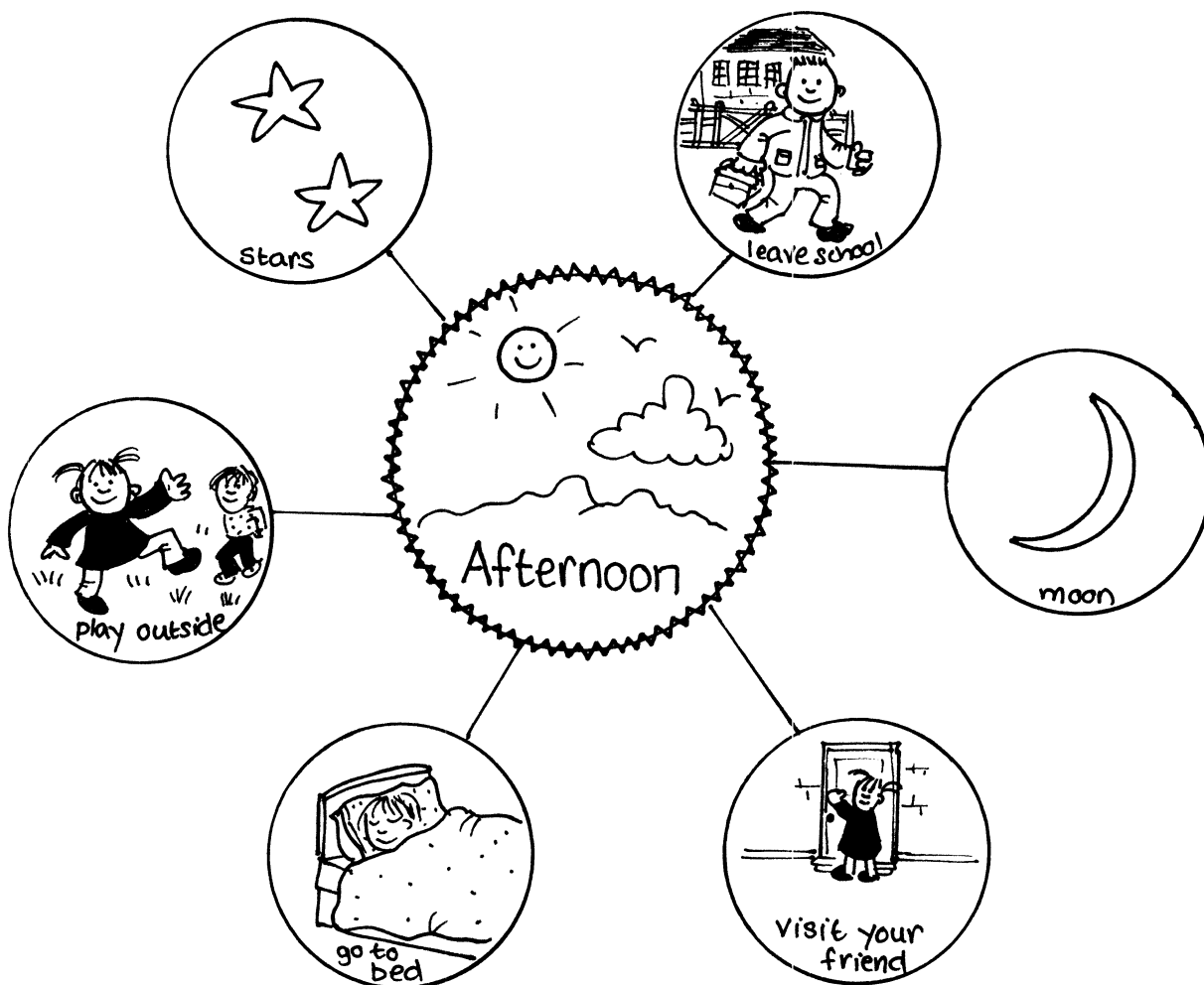
Look at the diagram at the bottom of this page. Tick the pictures of things you see and do in the morning... and cross out the things you don't see or do in the morning.

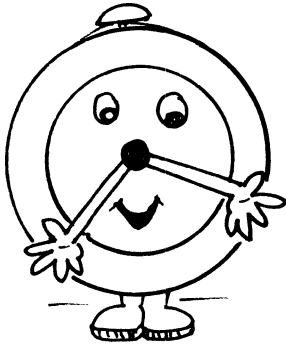




I like the morning because I hear the birds singing... but I don't like getting up early in the morning! Tell me one thing you like about the morning... and one thing you don't like about it.

The time after the middle of the day is called ... the AFTERNOON. 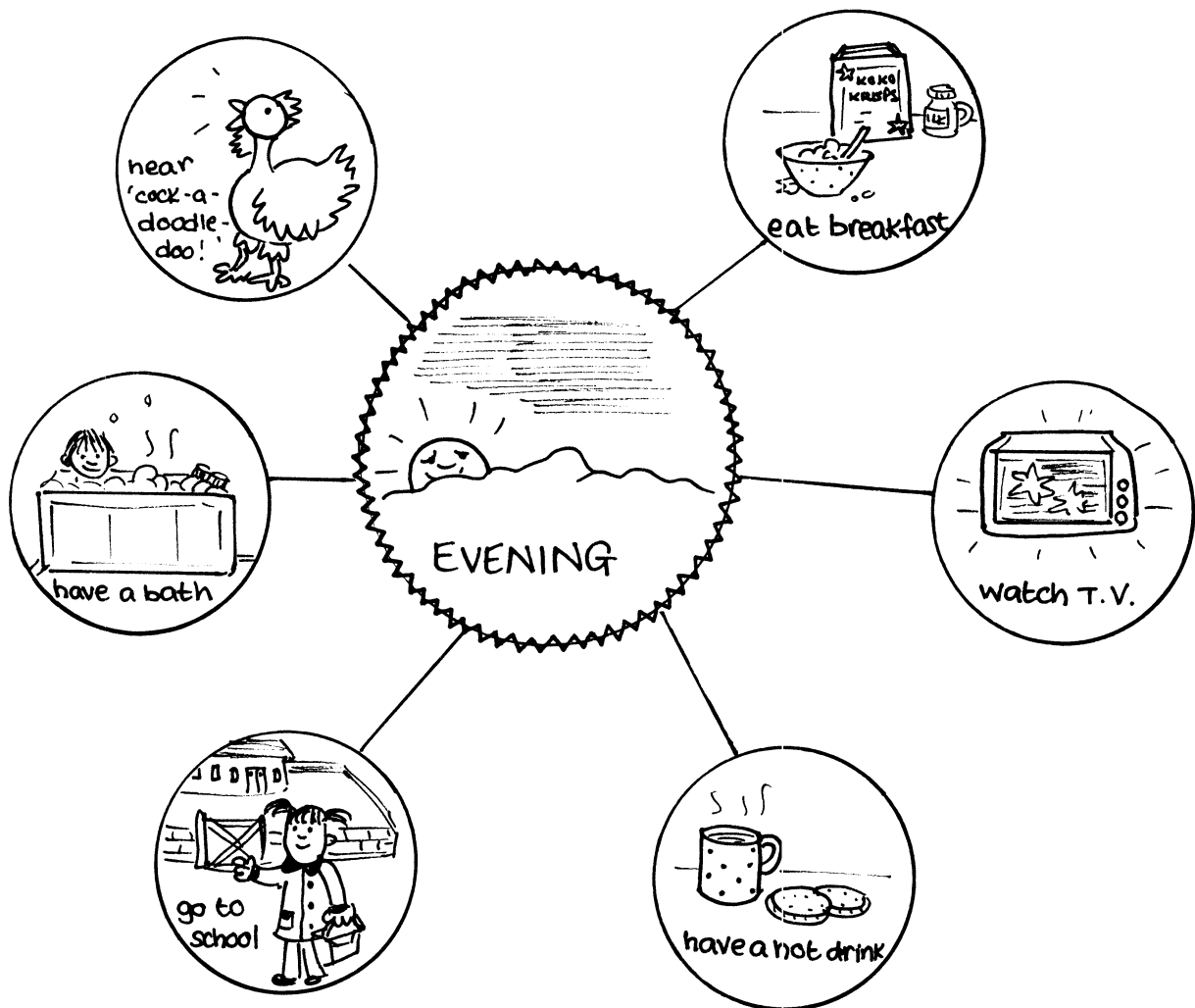


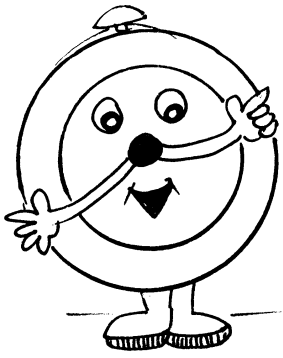


I like the afternoon because I go home from school and eat my tea
What do you like to eat for your tea?

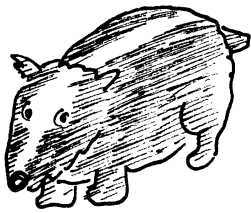
When tea-time is over, the next chunk of the day is the EVENING. This is the part of the day between tea-time and bed-time.

Tick the pictures on the diagram of things you might do or see in the evening... and cross out the things you don't do or see in the evening.

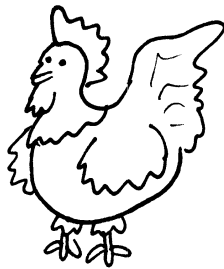

Then turn to Page 6.

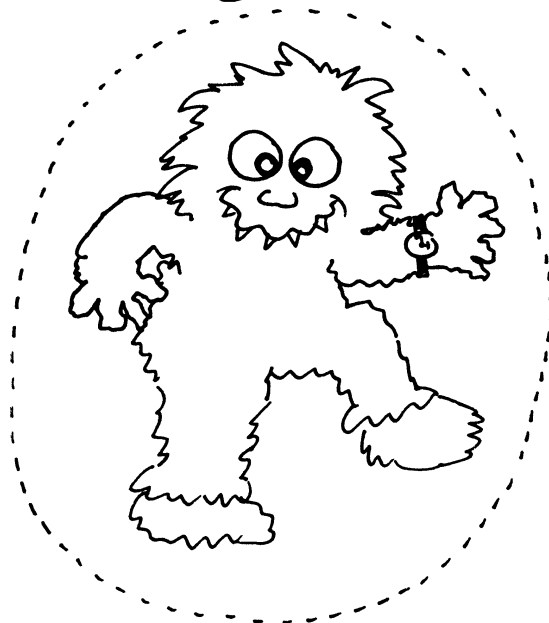
You will find a time path.

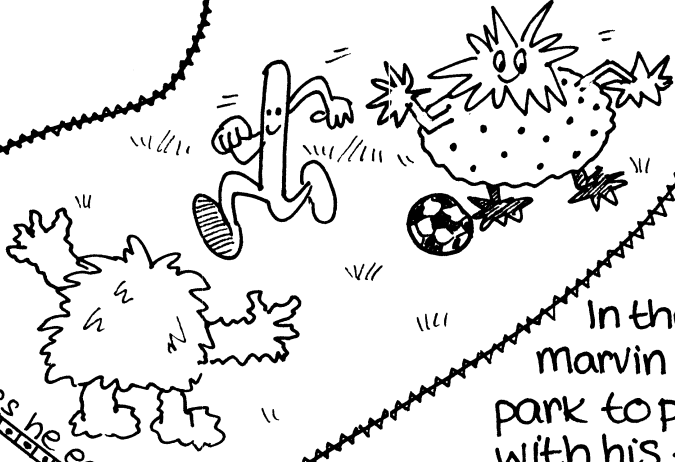

What meal does he eat now?



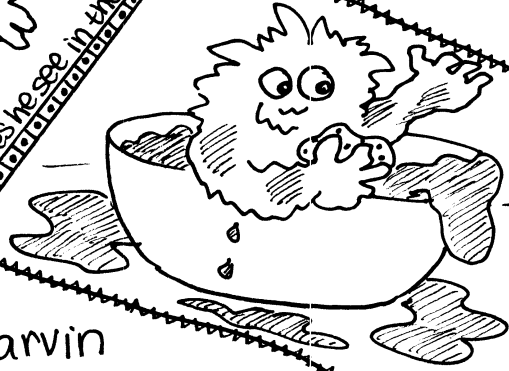
In the afternoon, Marvin goes to the park to play football with his friends

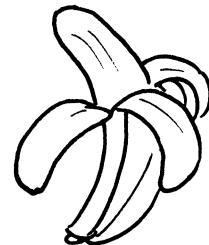
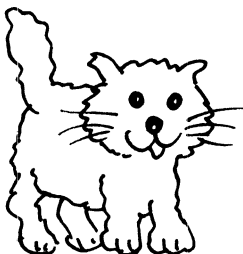
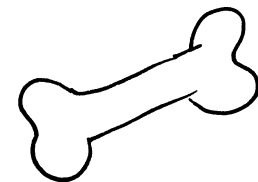
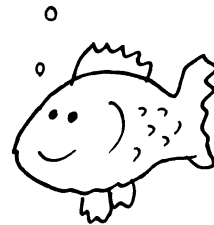
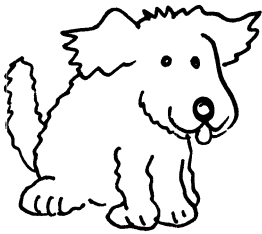
Now you know about the morning, the afternoon, the evening, and night... but I know some other special times of the day. One of my favourite times is ... DINNER TIME!

It's dinner time for these animals.

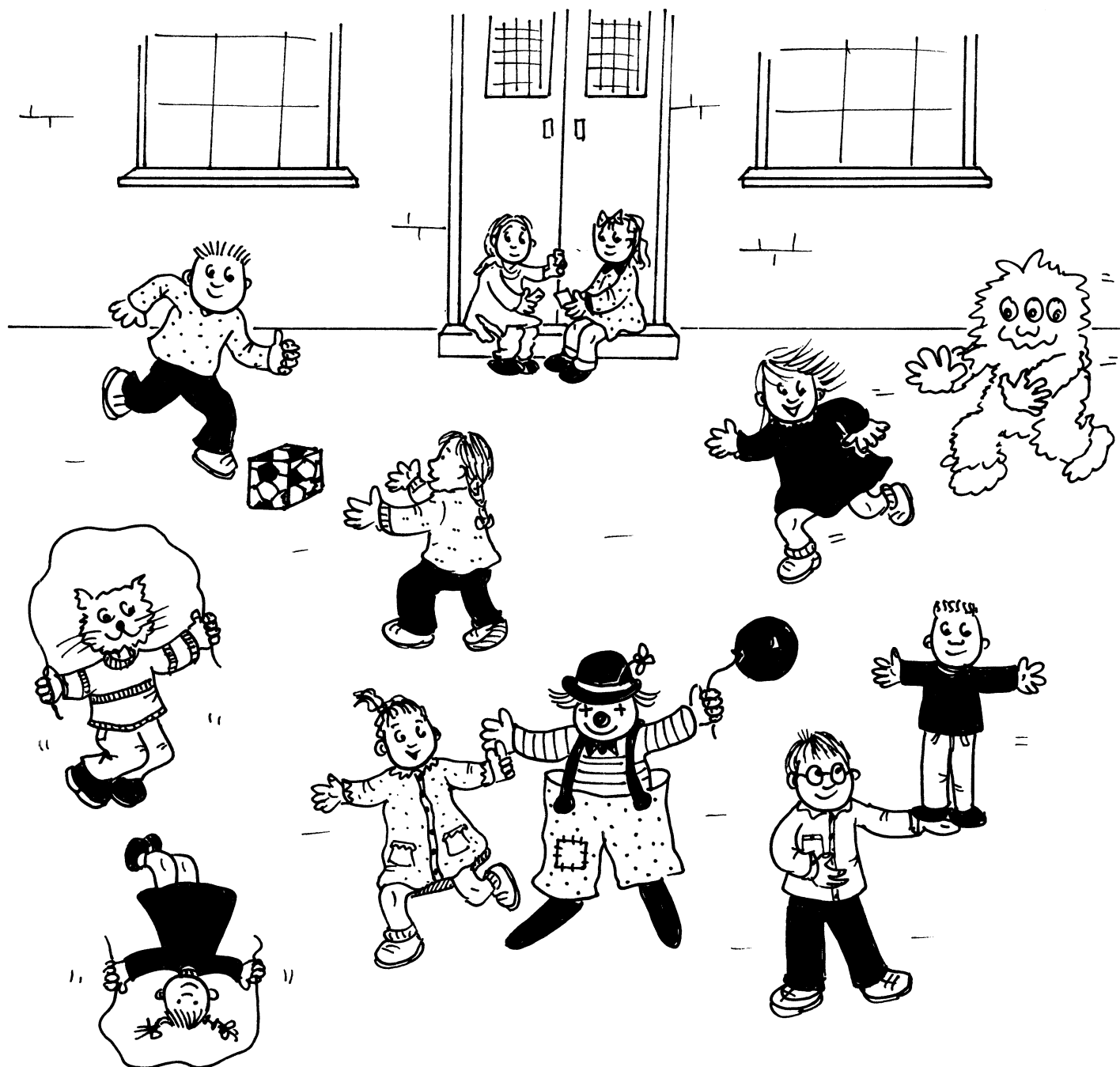
Draw a line from each animal to the food they would eat at dinner time.



An exciting time of the day is PLAY TIME.

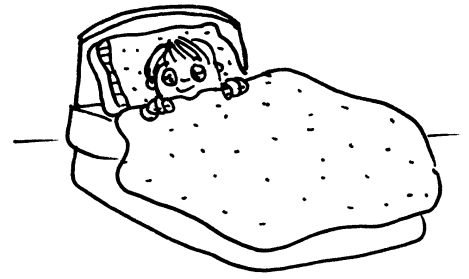
How many play times are there at your school?....

you find six silly things on this picture.

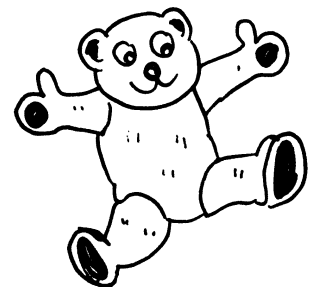
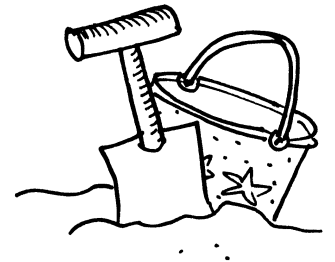
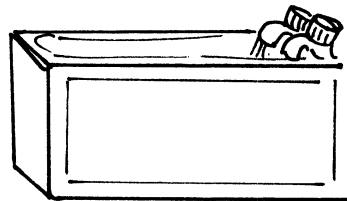
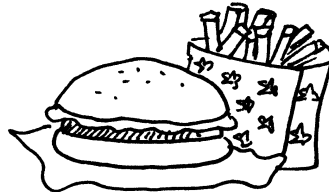
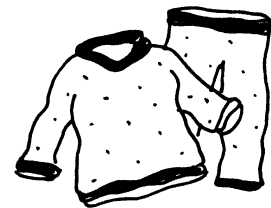
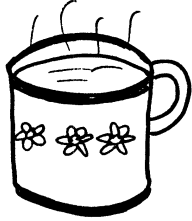


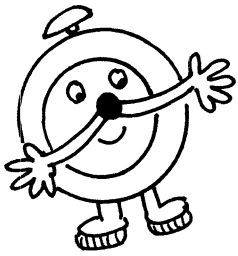

Now, it's BEDTIME! Some people don't like this time of day. Do you like bedtime? What do you do at bedtime? Tell me about your bedroom.



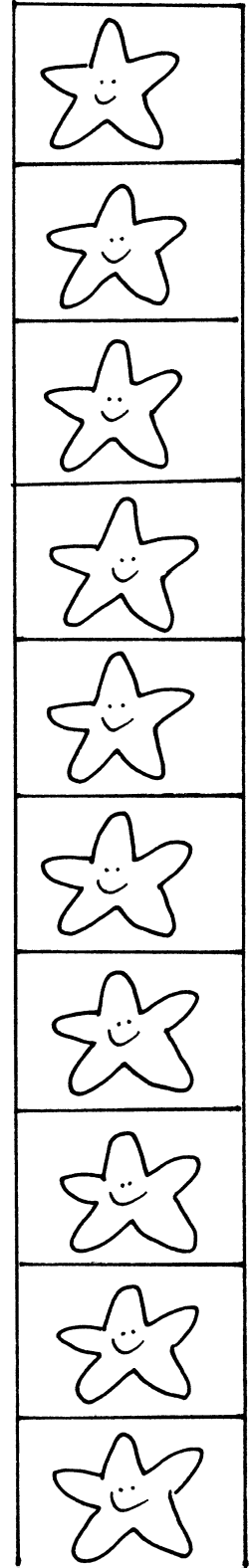
