Same / Different

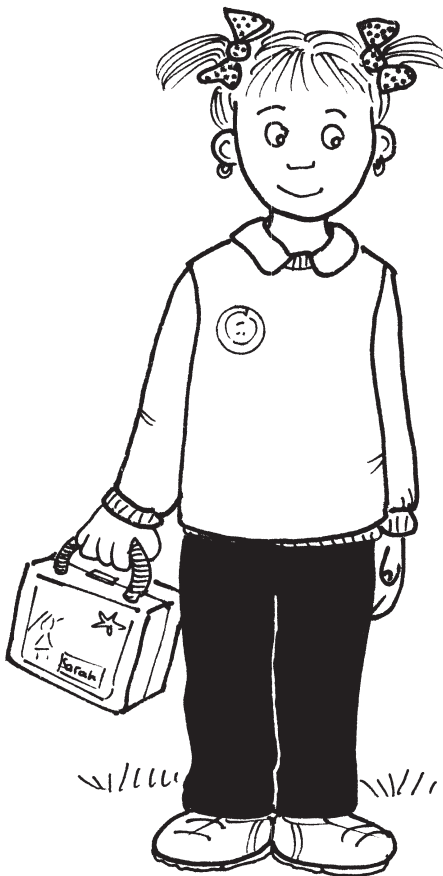
This is Sarah..... and this is Sophie.

What other things are different about Katy?

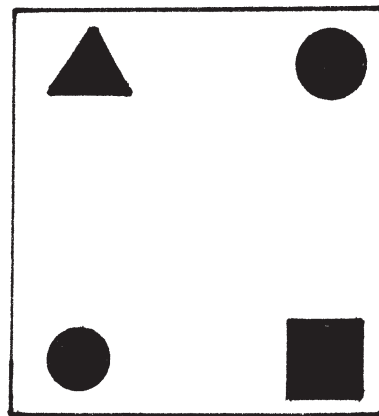
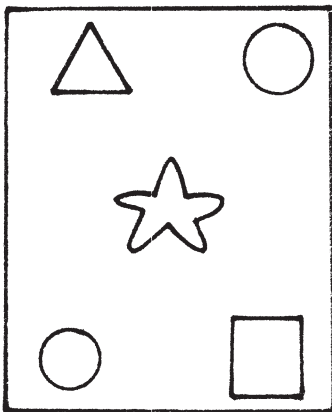
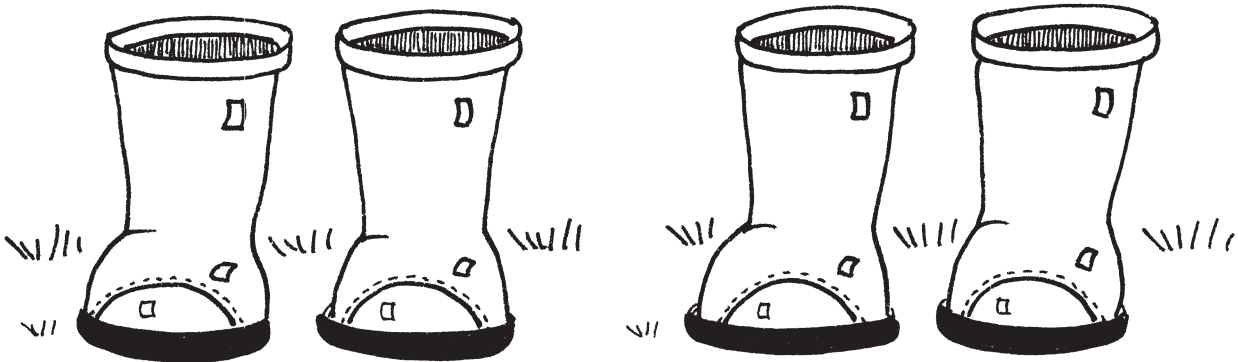
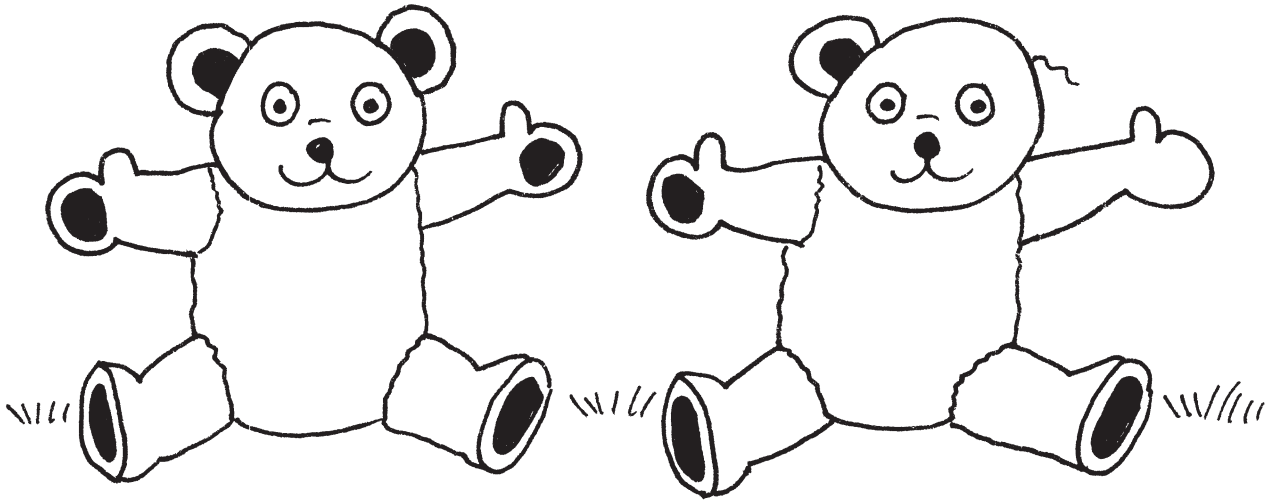

The Same or Different Game

This can be played in a one-to-one, or group setting.

Photocopy the SAME and DIFFERENT cards at the bottom of this page, several times, to make a small pack of cards, which are placed face down on the table.

Cut out the action cards on the next two pages, which are also placed face down on the table.

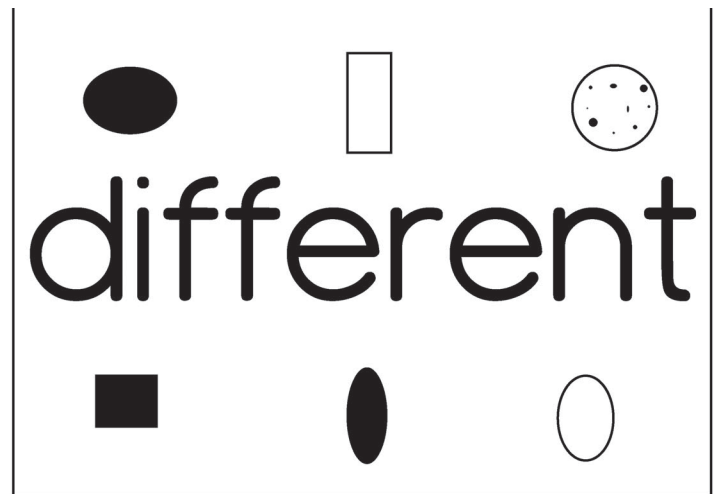
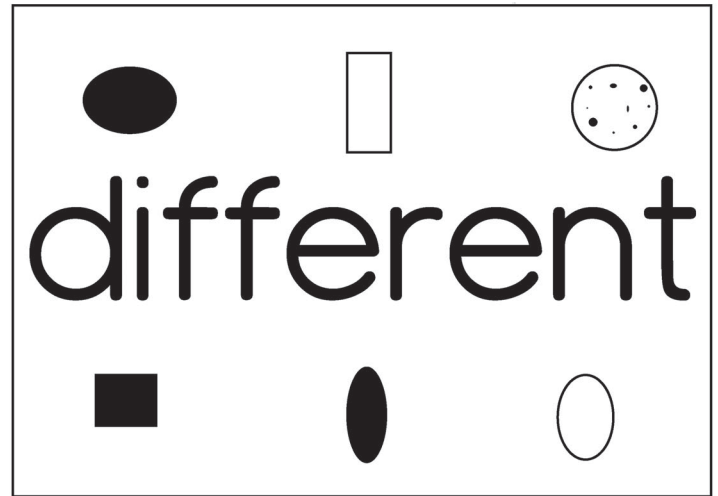
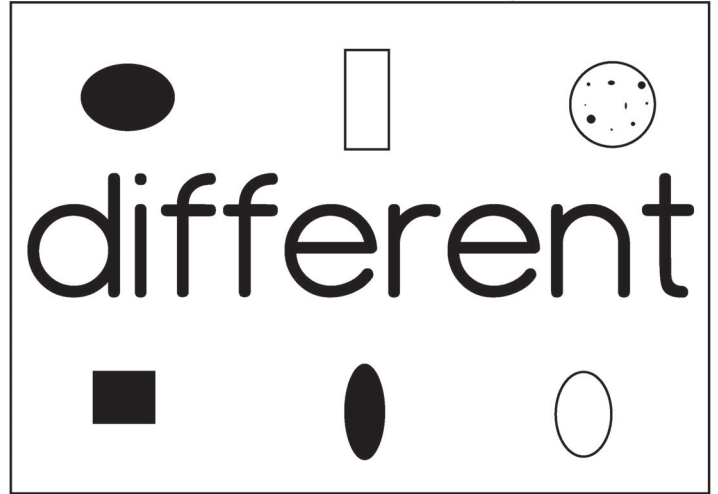
Explain that you are going to turn over an action card that will tell you to do something with your hands, feet, eyes etc. The child, or a selected group member, then turns over a card from the SAME – DIFFERENT pile.

If they turn over a SAME card, the child (or the whole group) must copy what you are doing with your hands or legs or feet etc.

If they turn over a DIFFERENT card, the child (or the whole group) must do something different with their hands or legs or feet etc.

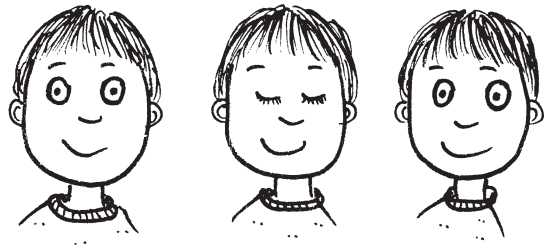
With younger children, you may have to help them think of something 'different' to do.

Encourage the children to use the words 'same' and 'different' eg. "are we all doing the same thing? Look at Ali and Jenny! Are they doing the same as me, or are they doing something different?"

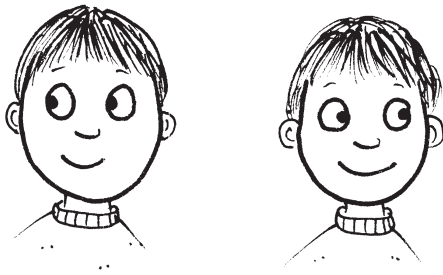
