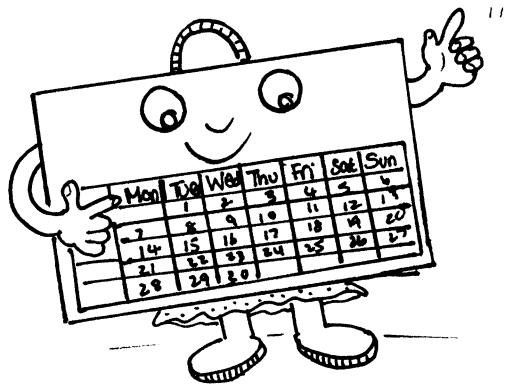

Thursday.....



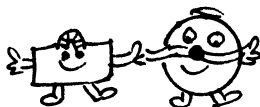
... is a learning day

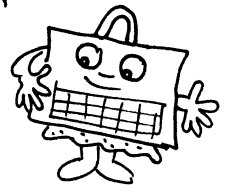
It's hard to remember the names of the days.

Say them as you move the spider up the ladder. Can you move all the way from the bottom to the top? Say the names of the days as you make the frog hop across the river. Does he get all the way?



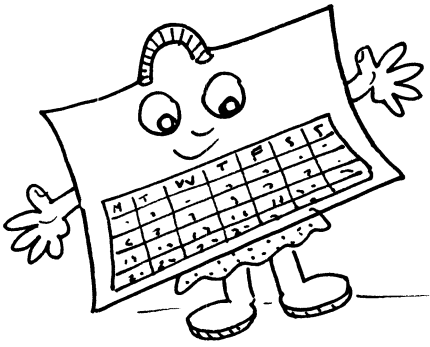
Put a tick or a cross against the days when you do ... or don't do ... these things.

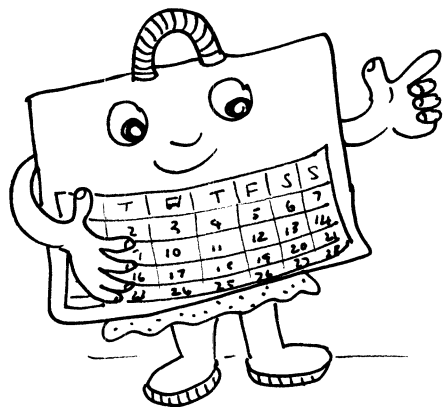
Maisie Monster is having a busy week. She is doing something different every day. Look at Maisie's calendar and talk about what she is doing.

For instance...

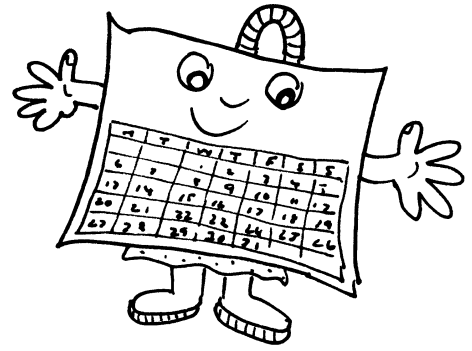
... you might visit your Grandma on Saturday... so draw Grandma in the Saturday box ....

Danny went on holiday last summer, and every day, he did something exciting.



He took photographs while he was on holiday – they are on the next page ... but ... oh dear! ... they've been mixed up.

Cut out the 'photographs' and put them on the table in front of you.

On Thursday... he built a sandcastle.

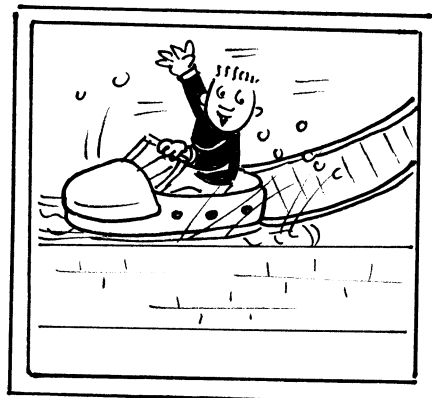
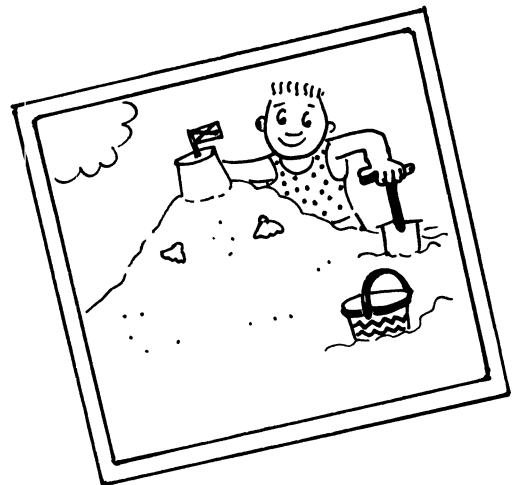
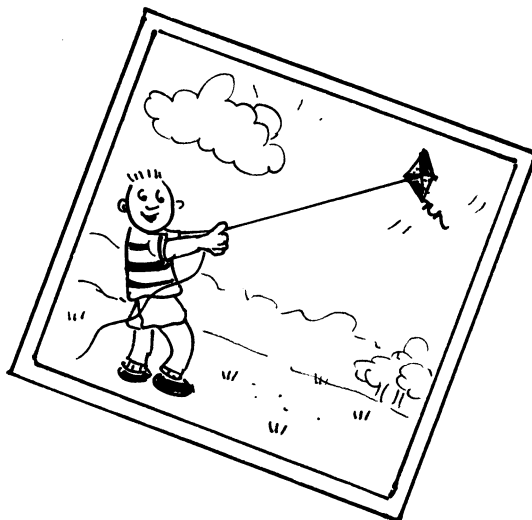
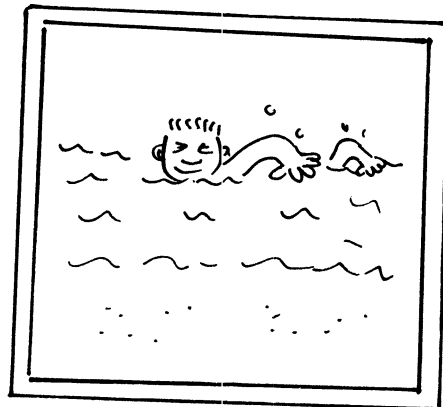
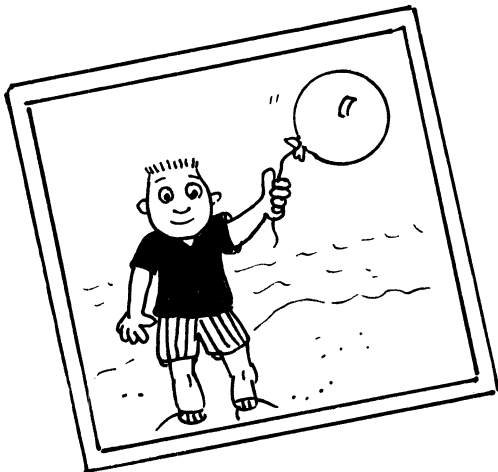
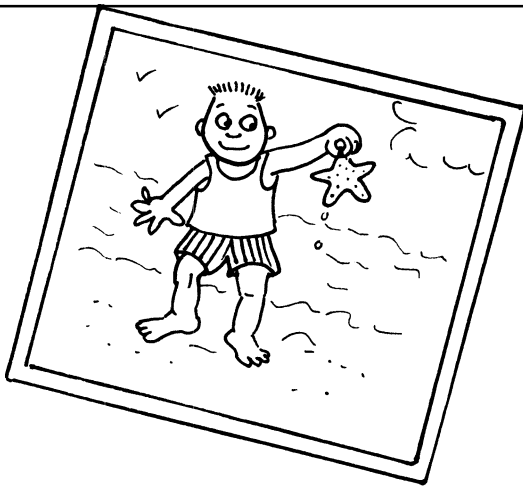
On Friday .... he found a starfish.

On Saturday... he went on the rides.

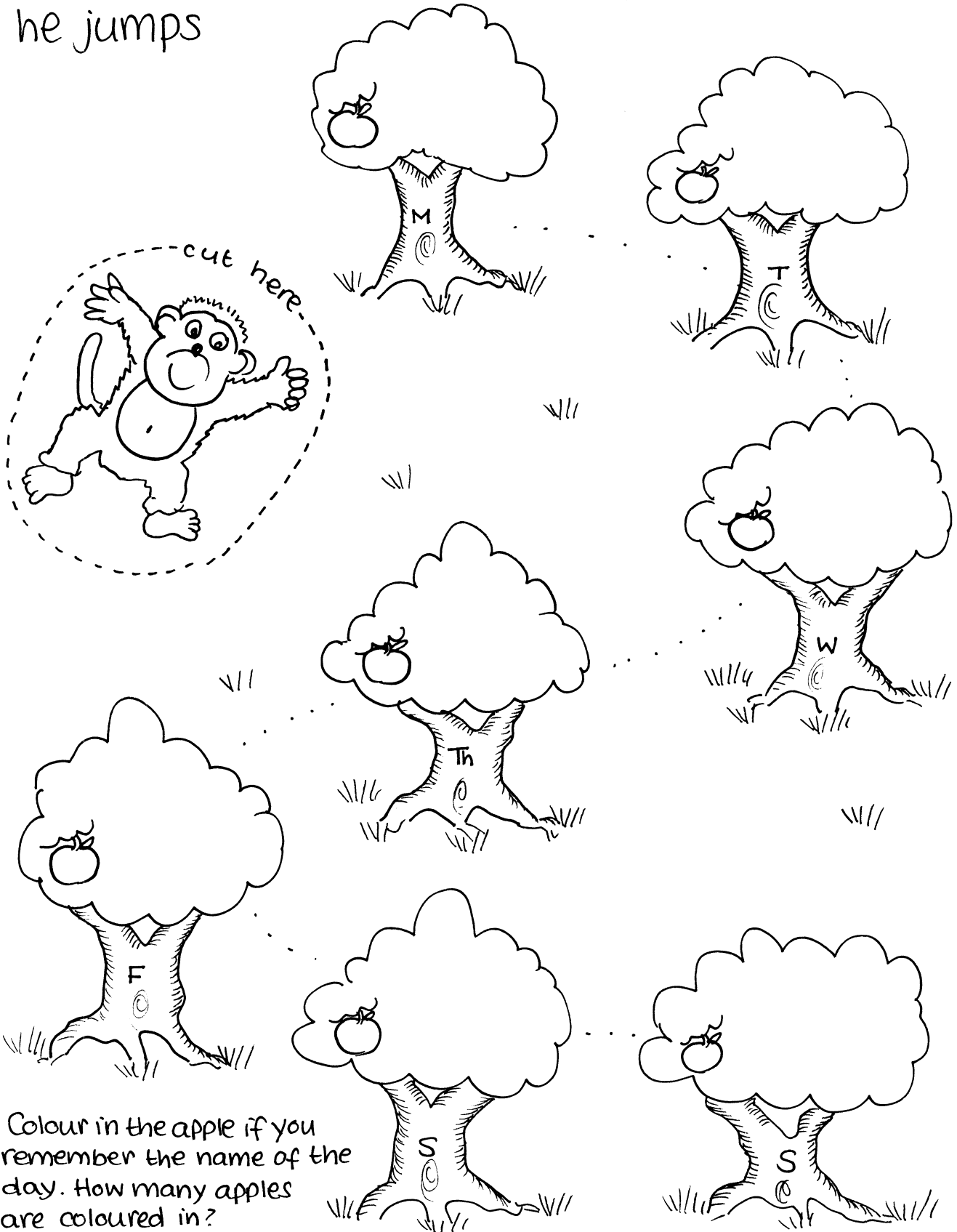
On Sunday... he bought a balloon

Now the pictures are all in line, play memory games e.g. "Take one picture away ... what day is missing?" "What was Danny doing on that day?" ... or turn the pictures over and the child tries to remember the day and activity before they turn it over.

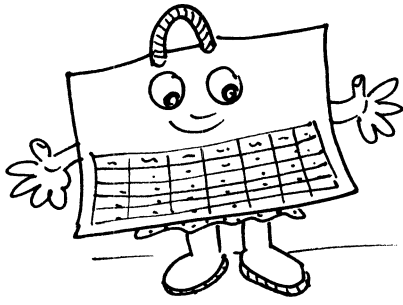




Here is your last chance to say the days of the week. Cut out the monkey and make him jump from tree to tree. Say each day of the week as he jumps

I hope you can remember  
the names of the days now...  
.... but sometimes, we don't  
use those names to talk  
about what day it is. We use these words...




TODAY.... YESTERDAY... TOMORROW

TODAY..... is the day we are in now.

YESTERDAY... is the day that has just gone.

TOMORROW... is the day coming next.

Look at what I'm doing in this time-line.

The today picture is in the middle. What am I doing today?

Now go back a day. What did I do yesterday?

Go forward to the today picture. What am I doing today?

Now go forward a day. What will I do tomorrow?



Look at the chart of Abigail's week on page 12  
Talk about what Abigail is doing on each day...  
... and colour in the pictures, if you want to.  
Cut out the pictures and lay them in a line on the table top.



Now ask the following questions...  
"Find Wednesday. What is Abigail doing today? ... but what did she do yesterday?" (Encourage the child to move their finger to the left)... "Yes! Yesterday, she was painting! Now point to Wednesday again. That's today... but what will she do tomorrow?" (the child moves their finger to the right)



Repeat with different days of the week.  
Example: "What day is it today? Friday!  
Let's see what Abigail is doing today.  
She's taking the dog for a walk....  
but I wonder what she did  
YESTERDAY?" etc.



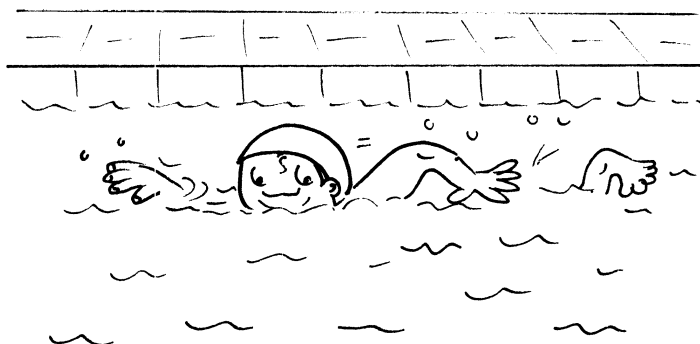

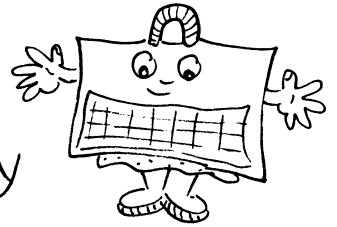
Here is some work to do at home

What is Winnie doing today?

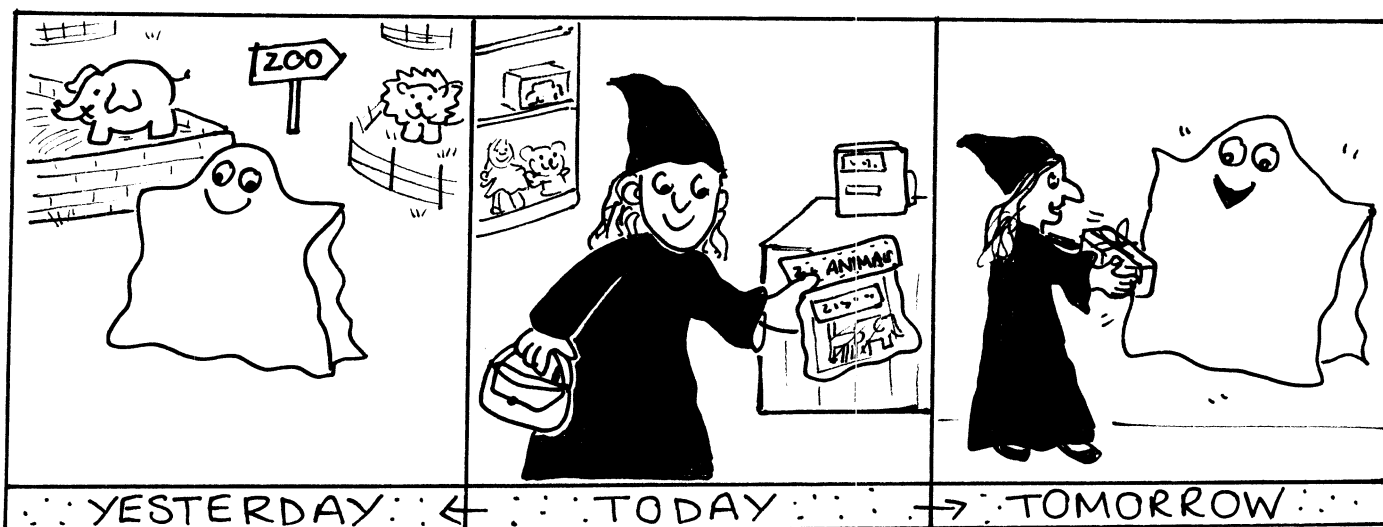
What did she do yesterday?

- When did Gordon go to the zoo?



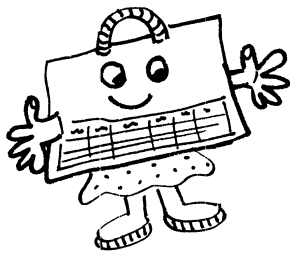


Today is Gordon's birthday !

 When did Gordon blow up the balloons ?



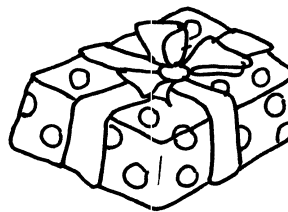
During the year, there are some special days that we look forward to...

(you or a grown up can write it in the box)

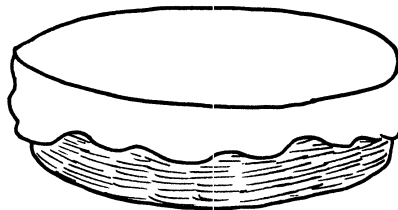
This is the day when you were born!

What do people give us on our birthdays?



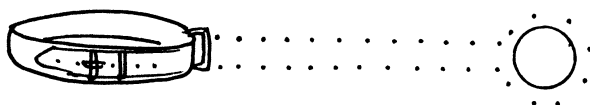
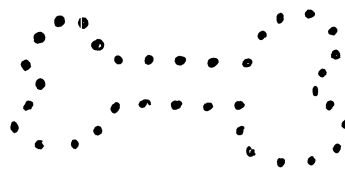
(Colour in the present)

(Draw candles on the cake)

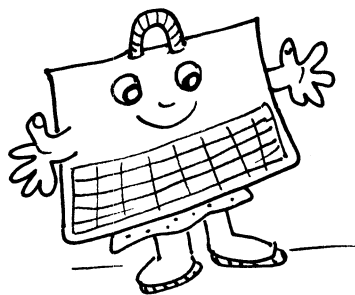
It's Daisy Dogs birthday. Join the dots to find out what she was given for her birthday.

 How many cards did Andrew get?

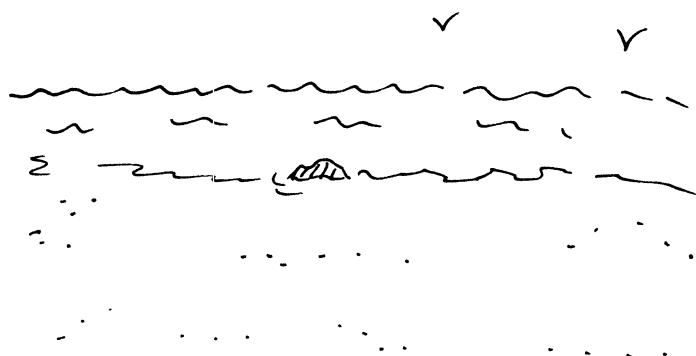


Another sort of day we look forward to is a holiday. Holidays are when we don't go to school... or work.

Some people stay at home on their holidays .... but some people like to go somewhere different on their holidays.

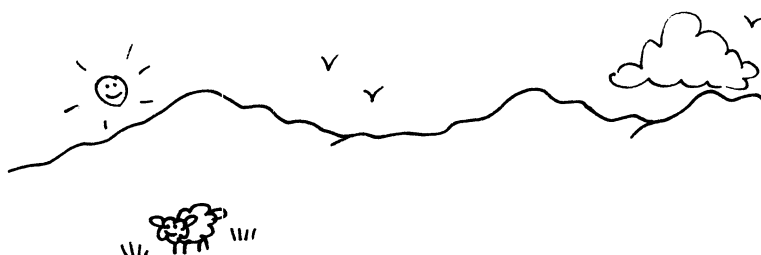
They might go to the sea-side...

(draw trees and more sheep)

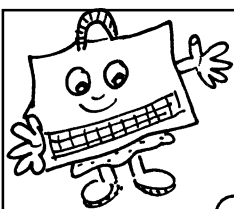


... They might go to a different country in an aeroplane.
