# Regularity and Spelling: Instructions for Use

This task looks at whether spelling to dictation is affected by sound-spelling regularity. Regular and exception words are matched (on a one-to-one basis) as far as possible for word frequency, imageability, grammatical class and number of letters, syllables and morphemes. Sound-spelling regularity was decided by consulting norms provided by Hanna, P.R., Hanna, J.S., Hodges, R.E. & Rudorf, E.H. (1966) **Phoneme-Grapheme Correspondences as Cues to Spelling Improvement** Washington: US Dept. of Health, Education & Welfare.

Some patients with acquired dysgraphia have particular difficulty in spelling words that have irregular or unpredictable sound-spelling correspondences (eg. Hatfield, F.M. & Patterson, K.E. (1983) **Quarterly Journal of Experimental Psychology**, **35A**, **451** - 468; Baxter, D.M. & Warrington, E.K. (1987) **Cortex**, **23**, 11 - 28). The particular constellation of symptoms has been referred to either as Surface Dysgraphia or Lexical Agraphia.

#### Special Points:

Find out about pre-morbid spelling ability.

#### **Descriptive Statistics:**

Norms are not currently available

Suggestions for Where to go next: If the subject shows a significant regularity effect on this task, test performance on Homophone Spelling [46]. Check for regularity effects in Oral Reading [35] (this set can also be used for written spelling to dictation). Also find out how the subject does in Picture Naming and Writing Picture Names [53]. Half of this set are regular words and half are exception words. Test performance on other spelling tests that manipulate lexical and semantic variables (eg. Nonword Spelling [45], Imageability & Frequency [40]).
