What is this game for?

This game is to help children to remember to put "s" on the end of plural words.

Cut round the 2 lotto boards on the left, and cut out pictures on the right individually.

.

What to do

2 children have a lotto board each.The small cards are placed in a pile, face down.Another child is the caller.

He takes one of the small cards and says what is on it e.g. "pencils" "cups" "car" "spoons".

The child who has that picture on their lotto board places the card on the same picture.

How it works - If the caller does not distinguish between words that do or don't have an "s" the others won't know what he means!
