What is this game for?

Children putting words together for the first time need to be able to join up ADJECTIVES with a NOUN.

This game is designed to help children to do just that.

In order to describe the picture accurately they need to use the adjective AND the noun. Just one word will not do!

What to do

Cut up this sheet to make 2 lotto boards and a set of individual pictures

Children take it in turns to take one of the small cards and describe it to the group. It is then claimed by the child who has it on their card.

Other Ideas

If you have more than two children to play you could add Describe Me 2 which gives you 2 more boards

Stripy, furry, spotty, chequered, floral, and a selection of colours
