

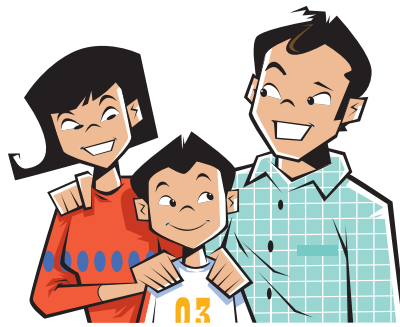
Help your child learn new words
