Homework for parents



Your child is a great word learner. At school he/she has been learning lots of new words. Part of being a good word learner is being a good 'word detective'. This involves trying to work out what a word means by him/herself, looking up words in a dictionary or asking other people.

Your child's teacher has given him/her this list of words. To help your child learn new words he/she has been asked to talk to you about what the words mean. The idea is that you tell your child what you know about each word. Try to use simple words to explain what a word means. If you are unsure about what a word means, look it up together either in a dictionary or online. It all helps with the learning process.
