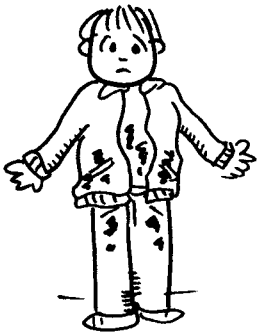
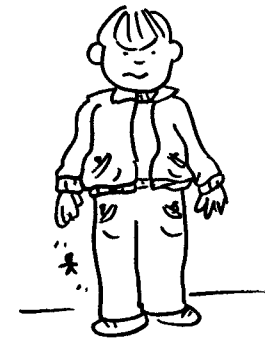


George was a greedy boy! He never shared his sweets with anybody. One day, George bought some jelly babies from Mr. Johnson's sweet shop.
