Robbie the Robot was a really good runner. He liked to run past the river and twice round the park every day.

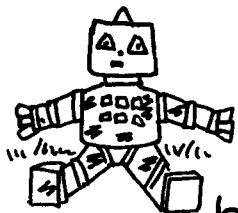
But one day, as he was running extra fast, Robbie hit his foot on a rock and fell right into the river!



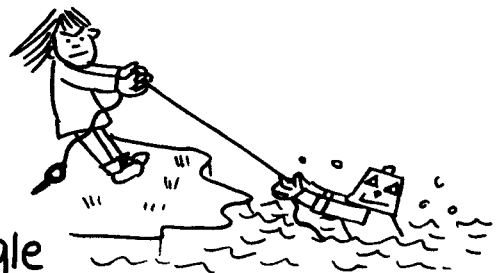
"Help! Rescue me!!" shouted Robbie. Luckily, Rachel was in the park, playing on the roundabout.



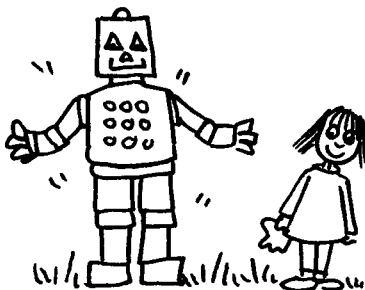
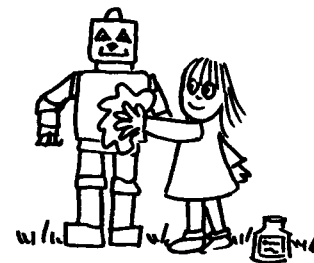
She grabbed her skipping rope and threw it to Robbie. She reeled Robbie out of the river!

Rachel came to the rescue again! She ran to her Dad's shed and got some rust remover. She rubbed it all over Robbie with an old rag.

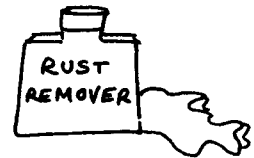
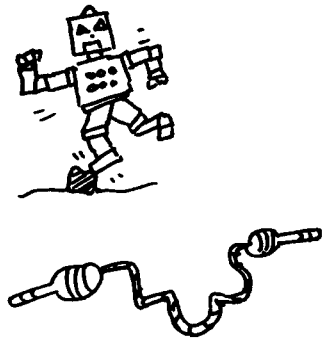


Soon, Robbie was as good as new... .. and he could run just as fast... .. but he never ran past the river again.
